Statement regarding REACH and Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC)
updated and published by ECHA (European Chemical Agency)

Dear Customer,

The REACH Regulation EC 1907/2006 came into force in June 2007 and the SVHC list has been updated and published by ECHA in June 2016.

We are downstream users for all substances and articles we are using. According to REACH, and as downstream users we have to rely on our supplier for the pre-registration of all raw materials.

We can inform you that we have received information from our material suppliers, that they have fulfilled their responsibilities regarding pre-registration according to REACH regulation.

We can further confirm that we are not intentionally using or adding any of the substances REACH classify as Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC). By confirmation from our suppliers, we can also state that the raw materials we are using do not contain any of these substances in excess of 0.1% w/w.
