Fluoroplastic is the generic name for PTFE, FEP and PFA, we only use virgin polymer to make our tubing, sleeving and heat shrink products.

We can confirm that none of the substances referenced in the EU directive 2015/863 (RoHS 3) are intentionally added during the manufacture of our Fluoroplastic Products.
