Statement regarding REACH – Chemical Etching

Dear Customer,

The REACH Regulation EC 1907/2006 came into force in June 2007. Adtech Polymer Engineering can confirm that where possible we intend to fulfil the REACH requirements, for all products we supply, within the set periods.

For all substances and articles, we are using, we are downstream users, according to REACH, and as downstream users we will request the required information from our suppliers, in order to, fulfil the REACH requirements. We have already started our communication regarding REACH with our suppliers, to gather the information that will be needed to ensure compliance.

Adtech Polymer Engineering can assure you that we are following the REACH regulation and will do our best to ensure that all materials in our products will be registered as appropriate.

We have been advised by our supplier of **fluoroplastic etch** that their annual production of this product is smaller than the minimum quantity required to become REACH or ROHS certified. As the procedure to become REACH certified is very expensive, it is not economically viable for them to offer a REACH compliant fluoroplastic etch currently.

As part of our continued effort in ensuring our products do meet the requirements of REACH, we are in the process of sourcing a compliant product.
