## Statement regarding REACH and Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC)

Dear Customer,

The REACH Regulation EC 1907/2006 came into force in June 2007. The REACH Candidate list of Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) was last updated 4<sup>th</sup> February 2026.

We are downstream users for all substances and articles we are using, according to REACH, and as downstream users we must rely on our supplier for the registration of all raw materials. We can inform you that we have received information from our material suppliers, that they have fulfilled their responsibilities regarding registration according to REACH regulation.

We can further confirm that we are not intentionally using or adding any of the substances REACH classify as Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC). By confirmation from our suppliers, we can also state that the raw materials they are using do not contain any of these substances in excess of 0.1% w/w.

We can also inform that we are not intentionally using or adding any substances listed in REACH Annex XIV (as of 12<sup>th</sup> December 2025). Neither are our raw material suppliers intentionally using or, the materials containing any of them, above regulated concentrations, if any of the listed substances would be used.

Based on information from our raw material suppliers, we can confirm that we comply with REACH Annex XVII (as of 12<sup>th</sup> December 2025) if any of the listed substances would be used.

Adtech Polymer Engineering Ltd are continuously communicating with our supply chain to ensure that the products we are buying continue to follow the REACH regulations.

This statement of compliance is true to the best of our knowledge of the current regulation. Please do not hesitate to contact us should you require any further information.
